



2018 **Tak Tournament**Information Sheet

Welcome to the 2018 Tak Open Tournament; a tournament for Tak, organized by the US Tak Association (<u>ustak.org</u>)

You do NOT need to be a member of the US Tak Association to participate.

You do NOT need to be a resident of the US to participate.

Registration is 100% FREE!

Registration is open to all, regardless of skill level.

Games will be scheduled through the <u>Tak Talk Discord</u> in the Tournaments channel. Your matches and running points accumulation will be pinned there as well.

Don't know how to play Tak at all? Check out this excellent, 2 minute <u>How To Play Video</u> to brush up on the rules.

Tournament Structure:

The tournament starts with a swiss match between all participants, with each match consisting of 2 games, scoring 2 games for a win and 1 for a draw. The number of rounds will be determined by the number of players. Tiebreaker will be determined by Direct Encounter, then Greater number of wins, then Solkoff, then Sonneborn-Berger.

Top 4 scores will then proceed to a single elimination bracket

Rules:

Standard Rules are used except where modified below:

- Games are to be played on playtak.com on a size 6 board with time controls set at 10 minutes with a 10-second increment(10+10).
- Each match consists of 2 games, where the players alternate starting colors..
- To keep to schedule, players must complete 2 matches per week unless directed otherwise by the Tournament Director.
- Tiebreaks for the Single Elimination stage will be a single cairn game, with draws going to the second player and first player being determined by coin toss.
