



# 2022 Tak Championship

## Championship Bracket

If any qualified players choose not to participate, replacements will be selected by tournament rating.

The format is single elimination. The quarterfinals and semifinals are 4-game matches, the finals is a 6-game match, and colors will be alternating in all cases. Games will be played on [playtak.com](https://playtak.com) with a 6x6 board, 2 komi, and a time control of 15 minutes + 15 seconds per move.

In the case of a tied match, a single tiebreak game will be played. For a tiebreak game, board size and time control are the same as above, and komi & colors will be determined by bidding: each player will submit an integer or half integer value of komi to the tournament director; the player who bid a higher value will play as white, with komi set at the amount their opponent bid +0.5. If both players bid the same komi, that value will be used and colors will be determined randomly. If a tiebreak is tied, a further tiebreak will be played with the same procedure.
